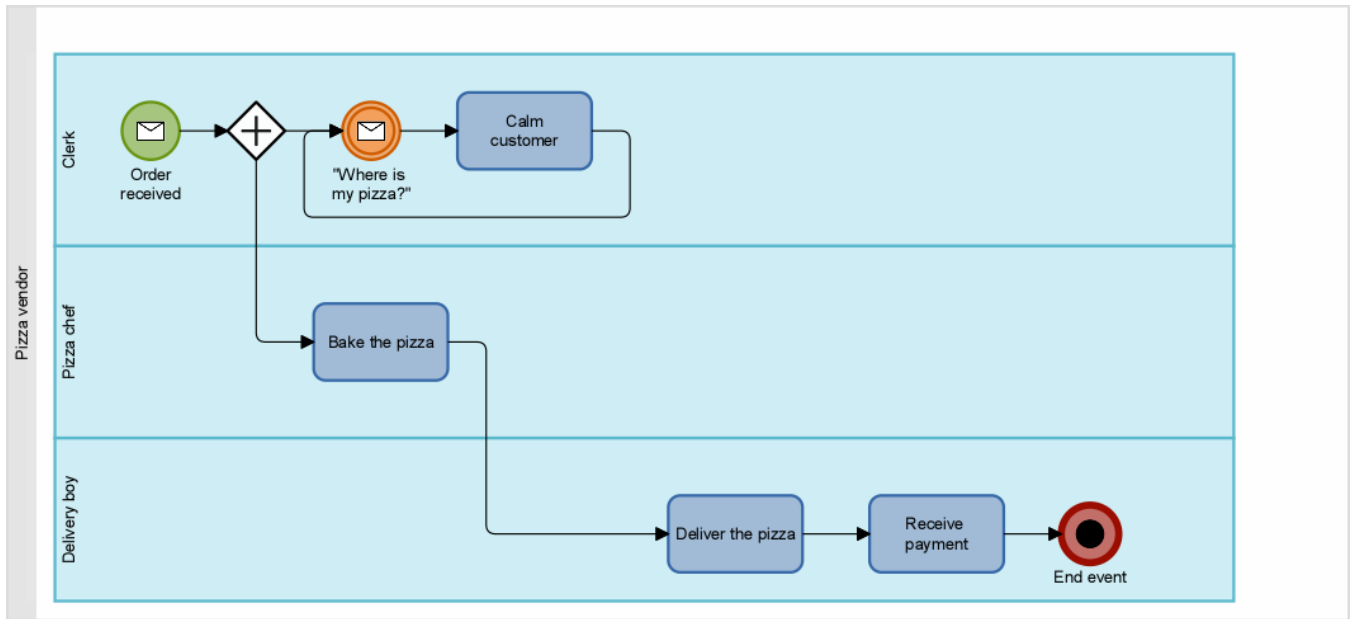


Lanes or lane sets in a BPMN pool are not neatly aligned with the pool


Problem

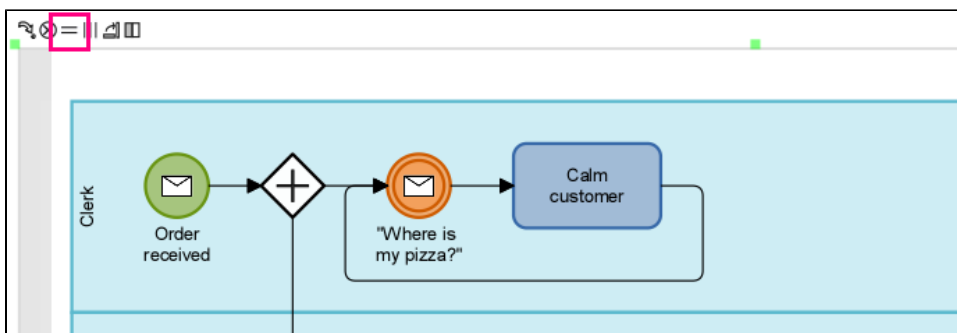
After creating a pool with lanes or lane sets there is space between the lanes or lane sets and the pool. They are not neatly aligned. An example is shown below. You can see the white space between the lanes and the borders of the pool.



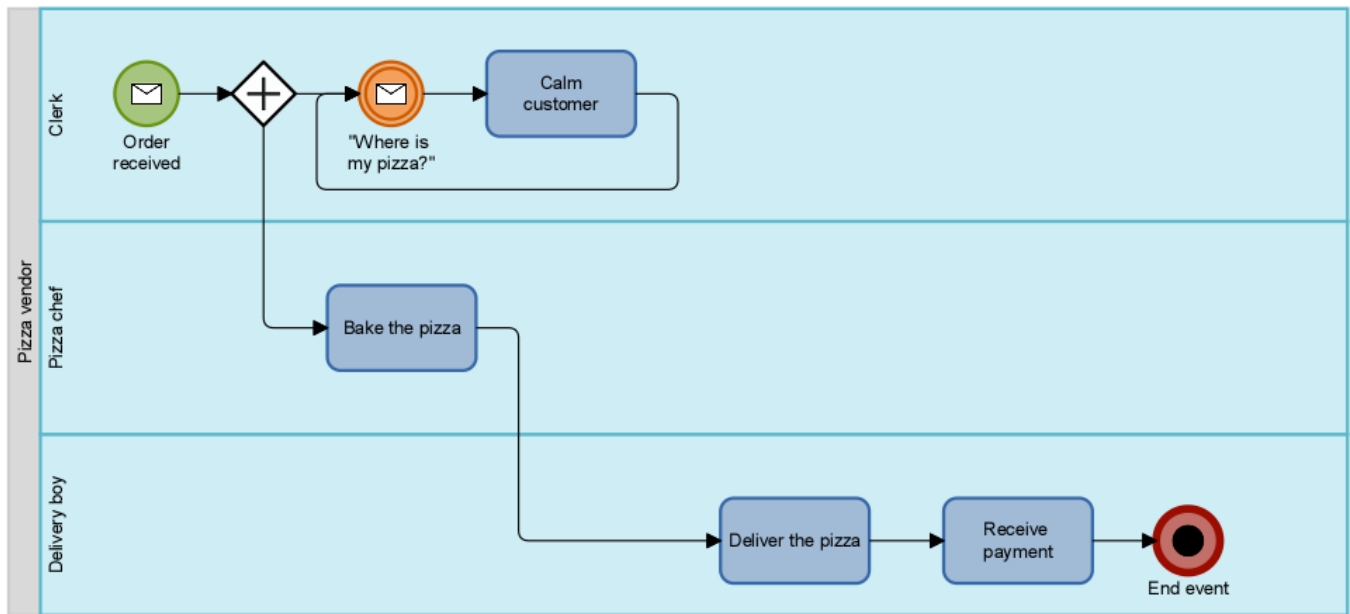
Solution

Lanes or lane sets in a pool can easily be aligned with the pool:

- Select the pool, and click  left on the top border of the pool.



The lanes or lane sets are now automatically aligned with the pool:



If you want to separate the lanes or lane sets again from the pool, just select the pool again and click \neq .
