


Changing the font size of a chart

The text used in a chart like the chart title, axis titles, and legend, all have their own default font size. If you change the font size of a chart, the chart title is resized to that size. After refreshing the chart, the rest of the text is also resized, maintaining the same ratio.



Steps:

1. Select the chart, and in the **Home** ribbon tab, in **Font Size**, select a new font size. The chart title resizes.
2. Click  on the left side of the chart. The rest of the text in the chart resizes.

It is not possible to resize the numbers in the bullets in front of legend items.
